The 1993 NCAA II All Academic Wrestling Team consists of 28 student-athletes from 24 universities and colleges. Twelve members were named to the first team and sixteen members were named to the second team. The University of Wisconsin-Parkside leads the team with three selections, two first team members and one second team member. Ashland University and Ferris State University each had one member on the first team and one member on the second team.

Brian Loeffler, an Agronomy major with a 3.53 GPA from South Dakota State University was named to the team for the fourth time. Marc Bauer from the University of Nebraska-Omaha, Ali Amiai-Eliasi from the University of Nebraska-Kearney, and Brent Loken from Augustana College were selected for the third time. Earning the honors for the second time are Dan Hutcheson from Ferris State University, Dave Lovy and Darin Tiedt from University-Wisconsin-Parkside, and Eric Wickham from Ashland University. The highest GPA on the team was a 3.68 earned by Myles Muckerheide, a sophomore from the University of Wisconsin-Parkside.

In order for a student-wrestler to be nominated for the NCAA II All Academic Wrestling Team, he needed to have a minimum of a 3.00 grade point average on a 4.0 scale. He must also be in at least his second full year of school, be a varsity member on his team, demonstrate a high degree of skill, and have a minimum of two letters of recommendation (academic advisor and coach) submitted on his behalf.

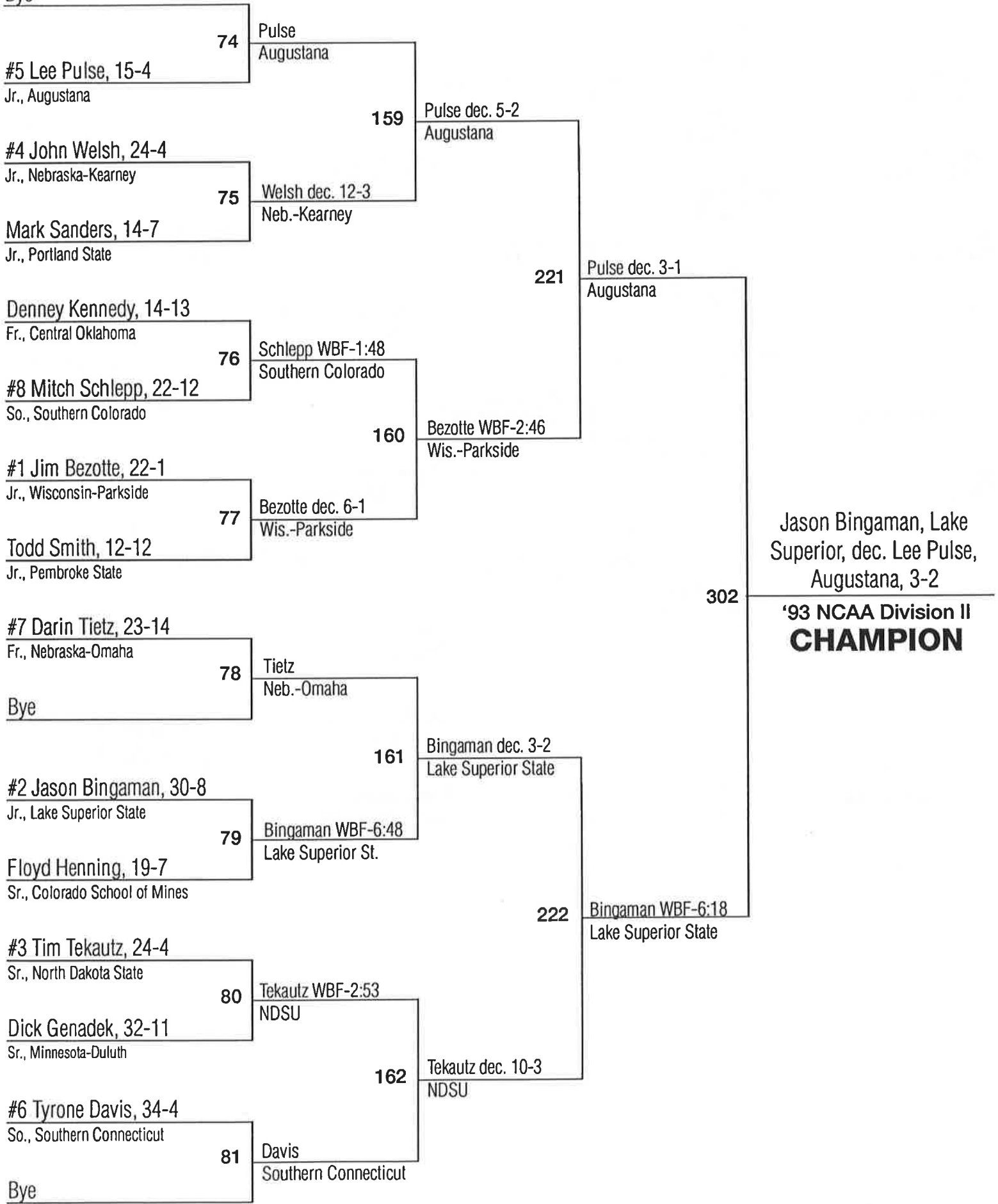


Consolation Bracket - Heavyweight

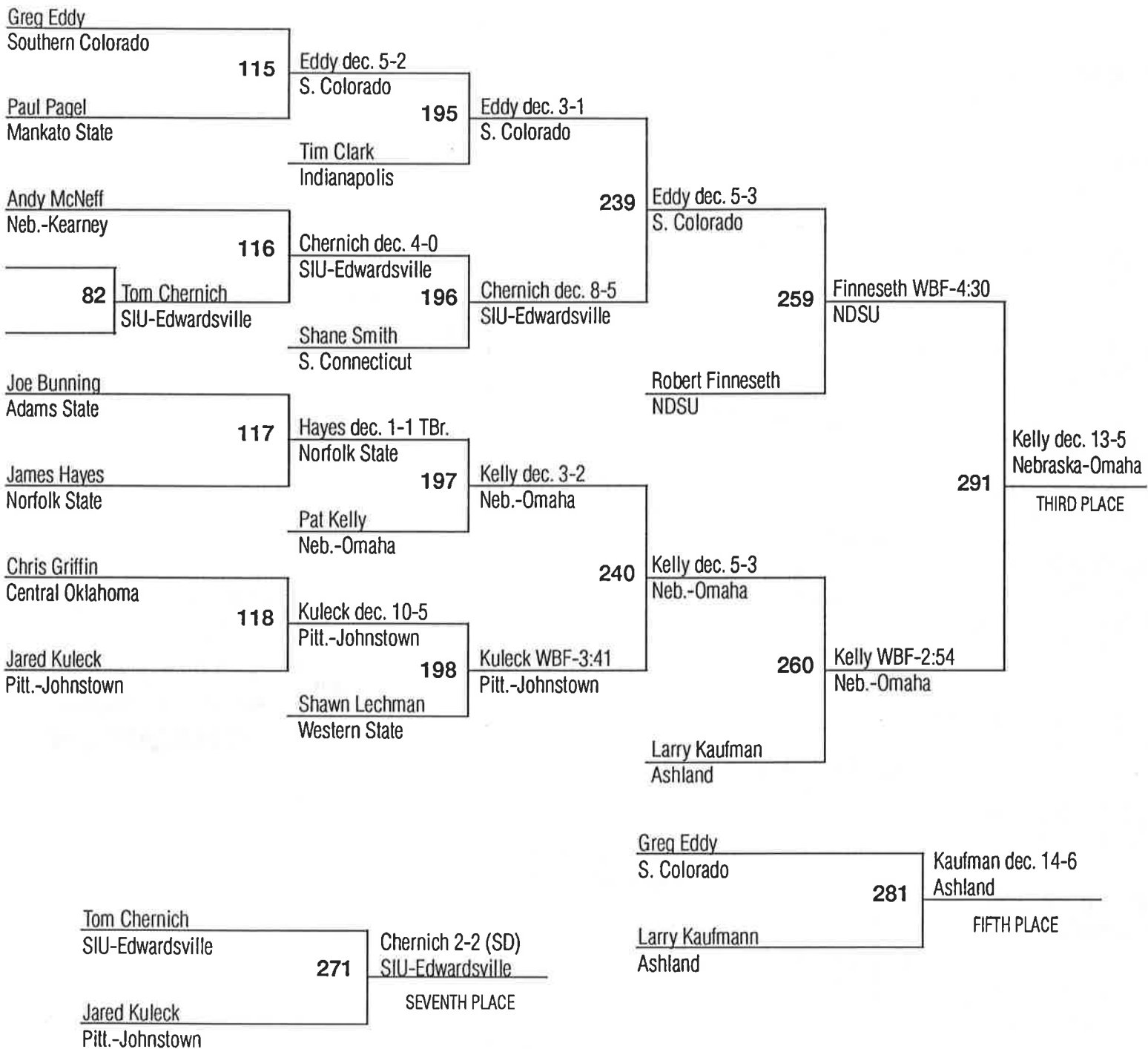
