# 1998 Championships

## **Highlights**

Not Even Close: Henry Gerten repeated as 118-pound champion and Jim Peterson won the 167-pound class as Augsburg romped to its second consecutive championship and third in the last four years at Young Arena in Waterloo, Iowa, March 7.

The Auggies, under Division III Coach of the Year Jeff Swenson, overwhelmed runner-up Wartburg by 42 points, the same winning margin as last year's, scoring 132 points. That total was the highest since 1974, when Wilkes won the inaugural championships with 1351/2 points.

Most Outstanding Wrestler: Rochester Institute of Technology's 190pound Matt Hamill became the first member of his school to earn this honor. The top seed in his class, Hamill pinned second-seeded Josh Dodd of Wartburg at 1:57 of the championship match. The pin was the Hamill's second first-period fall of the championships and fourth in four matches.
