The 1994 NCAA Division II All Academic Wrestling Team consists of 28 student-athletes from 17 universities and colleges. Sixteen members were named to the first-team and twelve members were named to the second-team. The University of Wisconsin-Parkside and Ashland University lead the team with three first-team selections each. The University of Southern Colorado, Ferris State University, Gannon University, Springfield College and South Dakota State University each had two selections on the team.

Brent Loken, a biology major with a 3.72 GPA from Augustana College was named to the team for the fourth time. Dave Lovy and Darin Tiedt, both from Wisconsin-Parkside, along with Eric Wickham from Ashland University were named to the team for the third time. Greg Eddy, from Southern Colorado, Larry Kaufman, from Ashland University, and Ben Loggains, from Ft. Hays State University, each were named to the team for the second time. The highest GPA on the team was a 3.84 earned by Andrew Reigstad, a sophomore from St. Cloud State University.

In order for a student-athlete to be nominated for the NCAA Division II All-Academic Wrestling Team, he needed to have a minimum of a 3.00 grade point average on a 4.0 scale. He must also be in at least his second full year of school, be a varsity member on his team, demonstrate a high degree of skill, and have a minimum of two letters of recommendation (academic advisor and coach) submitted on his behalf.
