The 1995 NCAA II All-Academic Wrestling Team consists of 33 student-athletes representing 16 universities and colleges. Nineteen members were named to the first team and fourteen members were named to the second team. The University of Wisconsin-Parkside, Chadron State College, and Springfield College lead the team with three selections each. Eleven schools have two selections and two schools have one selection.

Matthew Scripps, a senior pre-medicine major from Gannon University with a 3.52 GPA was named to the team for the third time. Named to the team for the second time were Tony Albertelli, from University of Pitt-Johnstown; Hyles Muckerheide, from the University of Wisconsin-Parkside; Kevin Bates from Northeast Missouri State; Burton Brinker from Gannon University; Clint Hilker from the University of Nebraska at Kearney; Pat Kelley III from the University of Nebraska-Omaha; Jake Menke, from the University of Northern Colorado; and Joshua Sammons from South Dakota State University. The highest GPA on the team was a 3.80 earned by Ricky Myers, a junior business major from Chadron State College.

In order for a student-athlete to be nominated for the NCAA Division II All-Academic Wrestling Team, he needed to have a minimum of a 3.00 grade point average on a 4.0 scale. He must also be in at least his second full year of school, be a varsity member on his team, demonstrate a high degree of skill, and have a minimum of two letters of recommendation (academic advisor and coach) submitted on his behalf.
