**EDMOND, Okla.** -- Nebraska-Omaha is the overwhelming favorite to win its third consecutive NCAA Division II wrestling championship in 2005-06, according to the preseason poll released Wednesday by the NCAA Division II Wrestling Coaches' Association.

The Mavericks, who won their second straight title by 8.5 points over Augustana (S.D.) last year, received all eight first-place votes to finish with 160 points in balloting of coaches from around the country and were the easy choice over No. 2 Minnesota State-Mankato.

Pittsburgh-Johnstown (Pa.) is third in the preseason rankings, with Augustana fourth and 2006 national tournament host Findlay (Ohio) fifth. Rounding out the top 10 is Central Oklahoma, Shippensburg (Pa.), Nebraska-Kearney, Adams State (Colo.) and Fort Hays State (Kan.).

UNO has nine wrestlers in the individual rankings, led by a trio of returning champions all ranked No. 1 -- 157 Patrick Allibone, 165 J.D. Naig and 285 Les Sigman.

Four other individual winners are back from last year and all start the season atop their respective weight -- 133 Andy Uhl of Findlay, 141 Thad Benton of Pittsburgh-Johnstown, 149 Pacifico Garcia of San Francisco State and 197 Corey Jacoby of Shippensburg.

The 2006 NCAA Division II Wrestling Championships will be held March 10-11 in Findlay, Ohio.

**EDMOND, Okla.** -- Two-time defending champion Nebraska-Omaha remained the unanimous No. 1 team in the first regular season NCAA Division II wrestling poll released Wednesday by the NCAA Division II Wrestling Coaches' Association.

The Mavericks received all eight first-place votes to accumulate 160 points in balloting of coaches from around the country and easily finished ahead of No. 2 Minnesota State-Mankato.

Pittsburgh-Johnstown (Pa.) stayed third in the poll, while Nebraska-Kearney jumped from eighth in the preseason rankings to fourth and Central Oklahoma moved up a spot from sixth to fifth.

Rounding out the top 10 is Augustana (S.D.), Shippensburg (Pa.), Adams State (Colo.), Ashland (Ohio) and Findlay (Ohio).

UNO has eight wrestlers in the individual rankings, led by a trio of No. 1s -- 157 Patrick Allibone, 165 J.D. Naig and 285 Les Sigman.

MSU-Mankato is led by top-ranked Travis Krinke (174), while UPJ has two No. 1 individuals in 141 Thad Benton and 184 Mike Corcetti.

**EDMOND, Okla.** -- Two-time defending champion Nebraska-Omaha will take the favorite's role into the NWCA Division II National Duals this weekend after the Mavericks remained the unanimous No. 1 team in the top 20 poll released Wednesday by the NCAA Division II Wrestling Coaches' Association.

UNO received all eight first-place votes to accumulate 160 points in balloting of coaches from around the country and easily finished ahead of No. 2 Minnesota State-Mankato.

Pittsburgh-Johnstown (Pa.), Nebraska-Kearney and Central Oklahoma remained in the next three spots, while Ashland (Ohio) jumped from ninth to sixth. Rounding out the top 10 is Shippensburg (Pa.), Augustana (S.D.), Adams State (Colo.) and Fort Hays State (Kan.).

Wisconsin-Parkside made the most impressive move, entering the poll at No. 12 after not being listed in the previous ranking.

UNO leads a loaded field for the NWCA Division II National Duals Jan. 14-15 at Cedar Falls, Iowa, with 15 ranked teams filling that 16-team bracket. The top 11 teams plus Nos. 13, 14, 15, 16 are all in that double elimination tournament, won by the Mavericks last year.

The Mavericks, who won the NWCA Division II National Duals title two weeks ago, received all eight first-place votes to accumulate 160 points in balloting of coaches from around the country and easily finished ahead of No. 2 Minnesota State-Mankato.

Central Oklahoma jumped from fifth to third in the poll, while Pittsburgh-Johnstown (Pa.) is fourth and Nebraska-Kearney and Augustana (S.D.) tied for fifth. Rounding out the top 10 is Ashland (Ohio), Shippensburg (Pa.), Fort Hays State (Kan.) and Wisconsin-Parkside.
