The 2010-2010 Division II All-Academic Wrestling Team consists of 160 student-athletes from 37 universities and colleges. Thirty-eight members were named to the first team, 35 members to the second team, and 87 were named as honorable mention. Gannon University and Augustana College each placed four members on the first team, while the University of Wisconsin-Parkside, the University of Nebraska at Omaha, Upper Iowa University, and St. Cloud State University each placed three members on the first team. Four student-athletes were named to the team for the fourth time. They were Cody Zimmerman from the University of Wisconsin-Parkside; Jay Sherer from Augustana College; John Sundgren from St. Cloud State University; and Evan Forde from Minnesota State University-Moorhead.

In order for a student-athlete to be nominated for the Division II All-Academic Team, he needed to have a minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 scale. He must also be in at least his second full year at his school, be a varsity member on his team or a key reserve, demonstrate a degree of skill and have a minimum of two letters of recommendation (academic advisor and coach) submitted on his behalf.
