The 2012-2013 Division II All-Academic Wrestling Team consists of 168 student-athletes from 38 universities and colleges. Thirty-five members were named to the first team, 48 members to the second team, and 85 were named as honorable mention. St. Cloud State University, Western State College of Colorado and University of Pittsburgh-Johnstown each placed three on the first team. Nine student-athletes were named to the team for the fourth time. They were Mitchell Schultz and Wade Gobin, both from Upper Iowa University, Nate Herda from Augustana College, Trison Graham from the University of Central Oklahoma, Matthew Baker from Maryville University, Arik Yde from the University of Wisconsin-Parkside, Tyler Nelson from Colorado Mesa University, Derrick Williams from West Liberty University and Christian Comito from the University of Nebraska at Kearney. Three student-athletes on the team have perfect 4.0 grade point averages. They are Chase Jackson from Grand Canyon University, Trevor Wentt from King College and Cole Ludorf from American International University. Mitchell Schultz from Upper Iowa University has the highest grade point average for seniors qualifying for the National Tournament with a 3.85.

The North Region dominated the academic competition with 17 of the first team selections, 15 of the second team selections, and 31 of the honorable mention selections.

In order for a student-athlete to be nominated to the Division II All-Academic Team, he needed to have a minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 scale. He must also be in at least his second full year at his school, be a varsity member on his team or a key reserve, demonstrate a degree of skill and have a minimum of two letters of recommendation (academic advisor and coach) submitted on his behalf.

Mercyhurst recorded the highest team grade point average (GPA) in the Twentieth Annual Division II All-Academic Wrestling Team competition and has won the Academic National Championship. This is the first time that Mercyhurst University has achieved this honor. Ten other NCAA II schools have also won the National Championship. They include the University of Wisconsin-Parkside, Fort Hays State University, the University of Indianapolis, Colorado School of Mines, Truman State University, West Liberty State College, Minnesota State University-Mankato, the University of Nebraska at Omaha, the University of Nebraska at Kearney, and the University of Mary . Nine of the top twenty academic teams came from the North Region, six came from the East Region, three came from the West, and two came from Midwest Regions. The Team GPA is calculated by averaging the cumulative grade point averages of ten wrestlers from each team of which eight of those wrestlers must have competed in their team's NCAA II National Qualifying Tournament.
