CHAMPIONSHIP FINALS

118 Pounds

GREG FORD, CENTRAL WASH., VS. MIKE ARNOLD, ADAMS STATE —

First Period: Both wrestlers moved cautiously in the opening minute. But Ford finally shucked Arnold for a takedown at 1:47. 2-0. Arnold escaped at 1:25. 2-1, Ford. Neither man came close to scoring down the stretch.

Second Period: Ford takes top position. Arnold escaped at 1:30. But Ford a head snap takedown at 1:23. Ford leads, 4-2. Arnold breaks free at 1:03. 4-3, Ford leading. Neither man did much as time ran out. 4-3, lead for Ford.

Third Period: Arnold on top: Ford escaped at 1:36. 5-3. Ford and Arnold each had a near head snap. But Ford scores a takedown ~~and~~ and near fall with 0:06 remaining for a 10-3 victory.

126 Pounds

ROBIN MACALPINE, CENTRAL WASH., VS. LDoug Samarron, Southern oregon.

First Period: MacAlpine a single leg TD at 2:43. 2-0. Stall warning on top to MacAlpine at 2:07. Samarron sits back inside and picks up a leg at 1:45 but can't get free. Off the mat at ~~x~~1:32. At 1:20 Samarron tried a roll ;but couldn't quite get loose. At 0:56, MacAlpine turned Samarron for three points with half nelson. 5-0, MacAlpine. MacAlpine countered Samarron's roll with 0:30 for a 2-pt. near fall. 7-0. MacAlpine rode out, leading 7-0.

Second Period: MacAlpine on top. Samarron escaped at 1:25. 7-1. MacAlpine near single leg TD at 0:27 but potentially dangerous. ~~xSamarron~~ Samarron quickly hits a duck under at 0:23 for tD. MacAlpine an escape at 0:09, 8-3. Samarron a takedown at 0:05 to make it 8-5.

Third Period: MacAlpine ~~x~~ was turned loose at 1:55. 9-5, MacAlpine. Samarron takedown at 1:25 with arm drag. 9-7. MacAlpined has 2:47 riding time at this point for a cinch point. MacAlpine warned underneath for stalling with 0:57. Correction, penalized for stalling. 9-8. MacAlpine was released by Samarron at 0:37. 10-8. Stalemate ~~x~~at 0:26. Off the mat at 0:09. Near takedown at 0:04 by Samarron. 2:09 riding time for MacAlpine makes the final 11-8, MacAlpine.

134 Pounds

DARREN HUFF, CENTRAL OKLAHOMA, VS. CLAY HOLLY, ADAMS STATE.

First Period: Double stall warning with 1:20. Holly takes time at 1:01. Was poked in eye, apparently. Huff hits single leg with 0:45, but Holly breaks it. Still no score. Holly picks up a leg with 0:06 but can't convert. 0-0 after first.

Second Period: Holly takes top. Stalemate at 1:32, as Holly had Huff tied up with figure-four ride. Huff turns inside and reverses with 1:14, 2-0. Huff bridged back and turned into Holly and nearly had him for a defensive fall. Huff warned and penalized for stalling with 0:40 for not taking Holly to the mat. 2-1. Holly escapes at 0:33 by breaking away from Huff's cradle attempt. 2-2. Huff hits 360 spin single leg at 0:26 but Holly counters with head scissors for stalemate at 0:12. Period ends, 2-2.

Third Period: Huff applies cradle at 1:53 but Holly slips it at 1:31 for reverse. 4-2. Stalemate at 1:05 on Holly's figure four ride. Huff rolls inside but Holly counters at 0:51. Holly turns Huff with figure four and Turk at 0:40. 3-pt. near fall. 7-2, Holly. Huff bridges back at 0:10. But Holly counters him to his back for 3 more points and adds 1:09 riding time for an 11-2 major decision.

CHAMPIONSHIP FINALS

142 Pounds

MERRICK WILES, HURON COLLEGE, VS. NATHAN WINNER, SOUTHERN OREGON.

First Period: Winner quickly picks up a single leg and converts it to a takedown at 2:32. 2-0, Winner. Winner turks Wiles at 2:22 for a 3-pt. near fall. 5-0, Winner. Winner turks Wiles again at 0:33 for 3-pt. near fall. Wiles escapes just ahead of buzzer. 8-1, Winner.

Second Period: Winner takes top. Wiles warned for stalling underneath at 1:27. Reverse for Wiles at 0:44. 8-3. Winner escapes at 0:19, to make it 9-3. Period ends.

Third Period: Wiles on top. Winner escapes at 1:37. 10-3. Winner works a high crotch for a TD at 1:07. 12-3, Winner. Wiles penalized 1 point with 0:52 for stalling underneath. 13-3. Wiles escapes at 0:20 and gets takedown at 0:15 to make it 13-6. But time runs out. Winner has 3:31 riding time to make it 14-6.

CHAMPIONSHIP FINALS

150 Pounds

PAUL SYVRUD, JAMESTOWN, VS. MARK ALLEN, CENTRAL OKLAHOMA.

First Period: Stall warning Allen at 1:40. Takedown Syvrud at 1:14. 2-0. Syvrud nearly has a near fall with a tight waist and elevator at 1:00, but Allen avoids it. Syvrud rides out. 2-0.

Second Period: Allen chooses top. Syvrud kicks free at 1:50. 3-0, Syvrud. Syvrud has one near single leg that fails at 1:25. Another ends in stalemate at 0:59. Period ends no more scoring. 3-0.

Third Period: Syvrud on top. Allen injures right shoulder at 1:39. Injury time out. Allen returns. Syvrud's tight waist and wristlock keep Allen tied up. They roll off at 1:10. With 1:00 remaining, Syvrud has riding time cinched. Stall warning Syvrud at 0:38. Still 3-0. Syvrud ride out. 3:05 riding time, 4-0 final.

CHAMPIONSHIP FINALS

158 Pounds

TERRY KELLER, WISCONSIN-RIVER FALLS, VS. JACK O'CONNOR, CENTRAL OKLAHOMA

First Period: O'Connor nearly had head and ankle takedown at 2:18. Keller avoided it. Stall warning O'Connor at 1:00. Keller throws O'Connor with inside body lock at 0:51, but they land just off edge. Still 0-0. O'Connor nearly has single leg, and Keller nearly counters for a throw, but they go off. 0-0 at buzzer.

Second Period: Keller takes top. O'Connor escapes at 1:54. 1-0. Keller calls injury time at 1:53 for eye injury. Keller warned for stalling with 1:17 remaining. Both penalized for stalling at 0:33. 2-1, O'Connor ~~Keller~~ leads. O'Connor a single leg takedown with 0:19. 4-1. O'Connor rides out. 4-1.

Third Period: O'Connor on top. Keller penalized for stalling underneath at 1:31. 5-1. Keller spins inside and reverses at 1:12. 5-3. Keller tries to roll the legs, but no near fall. Stalemate at 0:24. O'Connor penalized for stalling at 0:10. Keller rides out, but O'Connor wins it 5-4.

NOTE: Keller was No. 1 seed. O'Connor was unseeded. Syvrud at 150 is only No. 1 seed so far to win a title.

167 Pounds

TONY RAMSAY, SIMON FRASER, VS. SCOTT DUBBELDE, SOUTHWEST STATE OF MINN.

First Period: Off Dubbelde's single leg, Ramsay reaches through the crotch and took him down at 1:13. 2-0. Reverse Dubbelde at 0:31. 2-2. Ramsay escapes at 0:10. 3-2.

Second Period: Ramsay takes bottom. Ramsay escapes at 1:42. 4-2. Ramsay ;converts a single leg TD at 1:26 to make it 6-2. Dubbelde switches at 0:54. 6-4. Ramsay escapes at 0:02. 7-4, Ramsay.

Third Period: Ramsay on top. Ramsay warned for stalling on top at 1:49. Dubbelde escapes at 1:42. 7-5, Ramsay leads. Dubbelde nearly has takedown at 0:45. Dubbelde warned for ;stalling at 0:15. Dubbelde Picks up a leg at 0:06 and dumps Ramsay, but Ramsay's hiplock holds him off at buzzer. Side judge confers with referee and decision is changed. Takedown awarded Dubbelde ties it, 7-7.

First Overtime Period: Ramsay slips Dubbelde's headlock for Takedown at 0:38. Dubbelde almost reverses at 0:21. Ramsay rides out. 2-0.

Second Overtime Period: Dubbelde takes top. Ramsay escapes at 0:26. 3-0, Ramsay leads. Ramsay barely misses takedown at buzzer.

Third Overtime Period: Stall wning Ramsay on top at 0:47. Ramsay rides out, adding 1:08 riding time for a 7-7, 4-0 decision.

BENNY COLEMAN, CENTRAL OKLAHOMA, VS. RUSS HANSON, SOUTHERN OREGON.

First Period: Coleman hits a single leg and converts to a double leg for takedown at 1:37. 2-0. Coleman hooks up <sup>cradle</sup> with 0:45 and gets near fall at 0:38. Hanson rolls out at 0:20. 5-0, Coleman. Coleman rides out. 5-0.

Second Period: Coleman chooses top. Hanson almost slips through cradle at 1:19. But no points either way. Still 5-0. Stall warning Coleman on top at 0:33. Coleman rode out. 5-0.

Third Period: Hanson on top. Coleman escapes at 1:55. 6-0. Coleman near double leg takedown at 0:36 near edge of mat. Still 6-0. No further scoring. Coleman adds 3:32 riding time, 7-0.~~x~~

CHAMPIONSHIP FINALS

190 Pounds

TOM BOERGER, JAMESTOWN, VS. LARI MERTENS, MESA.

First Period: Boerger hits a single leg takedown at 2:32. 2-0. Mertens escapes at 2:05. He was warned for stalling at 2:19. 2-1. Boerger gets takedown and cradle at 1:39 for x 2-pt. near fall. 6-1. Reverse by Mertens with 1:05. 6-3. Boerger escapes at 0:25. 7-3. Mertens comes back with a single leg takedown at 0:17. 7-5. Mertens rode out. 7-5, Boerger leads.

Second Period: Boerger taked bottom. Mertens turns Boerger at 1:25 for 2-pt. near fall. Score tied 7-7. Boerger asks for injury time. Boerger escapes at 0:48. He leads, 8-7. ~~8-7~~ No further scoring. 8-7, Boerger.

Third Period: Boerger on top. Mertens reverses in only 4 seconds. 9-8, Mertens. Boerger reverses at 1:05. He leads, 10-9. Correction. Ruled escape and takedown. It's 11-9 ;Mertens. He escapes at 0:48 to x make it 11-10. Mertens has 1:19 riding time. Boerger warned at 0:11. Mertens takes Boerger down at x 0:06. Rides out xfor 13-11 win, counting 1:25 riding time.
