### NATIONAL WRESTLING TOURNAMENT

Despite small crowds and fewer entries than expected, the second annual NAIA national wrestling tournament at Northern Illinois University in DeKalb on March 20-21 was called "an outstanding success" by tournament officials. A total of 84 matches were run-off in the 2-day event.

Collegiate wrestling was at its best as a field of 76 contestants from 21 schools in 11 different states vied for ten individual championships and the team crown. Mankato (Minn.) State College repeated its 1958 feat by walking away with team honors. The Mankato squad turned in performances that resulted in two individual champs, three second places and two thirds.

The second place team, Southern Illinois University of Carbondale, had three individual champions, one runner-up and one third. Lock Haven (Pa.) State Teachers finished third and had two champs, one runner-up and one third place wrestler. Individual champions also went to Central Michigan College of Mt. Pleasant, Illinois State Normal of Normal and Winona (Minn.) State College.

The championship rounds marked the beginning of upsets as three of the 1958 champs made unsuccessful bids for crowns. In dethroning Jack Thamert of Mankato from the 115-pound title, Gray Simons of Lock Haven showed such form and craftsmanship that he was named outstanding wrestler of the tournament.

Jerry Wedemeier, NAIA's new heavyweight champ from Winona, won the trophy for turning in the fastest pin (2:19) in the tournament. Simons and Wedemeier are college freshmen.

Individual championships were equally divided between under and upper classmen. Two champs are freshmen, three are sophomores, two are juniors and three are seniors.
