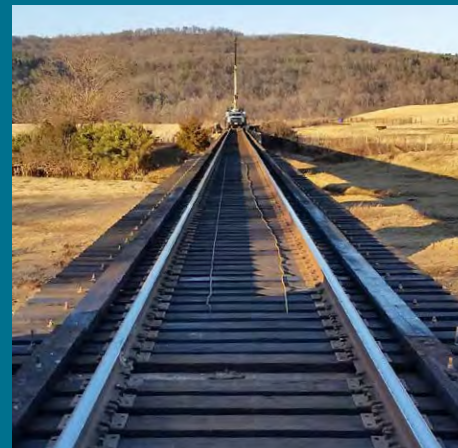

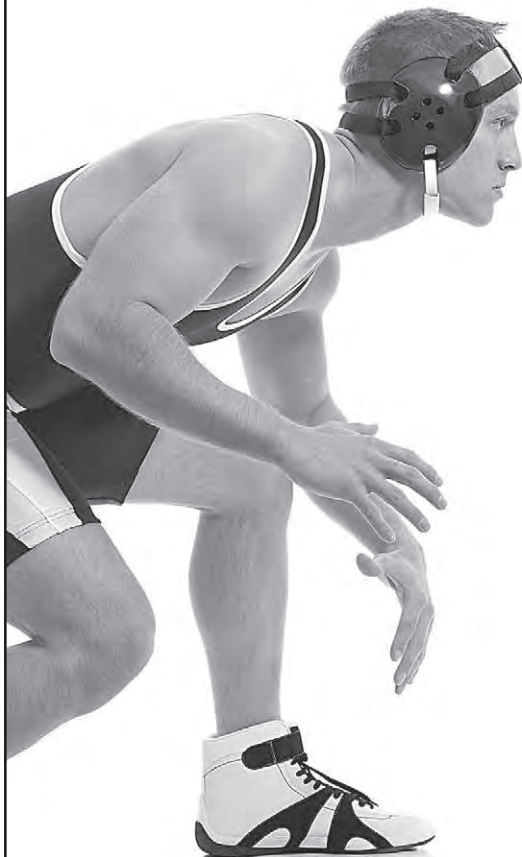

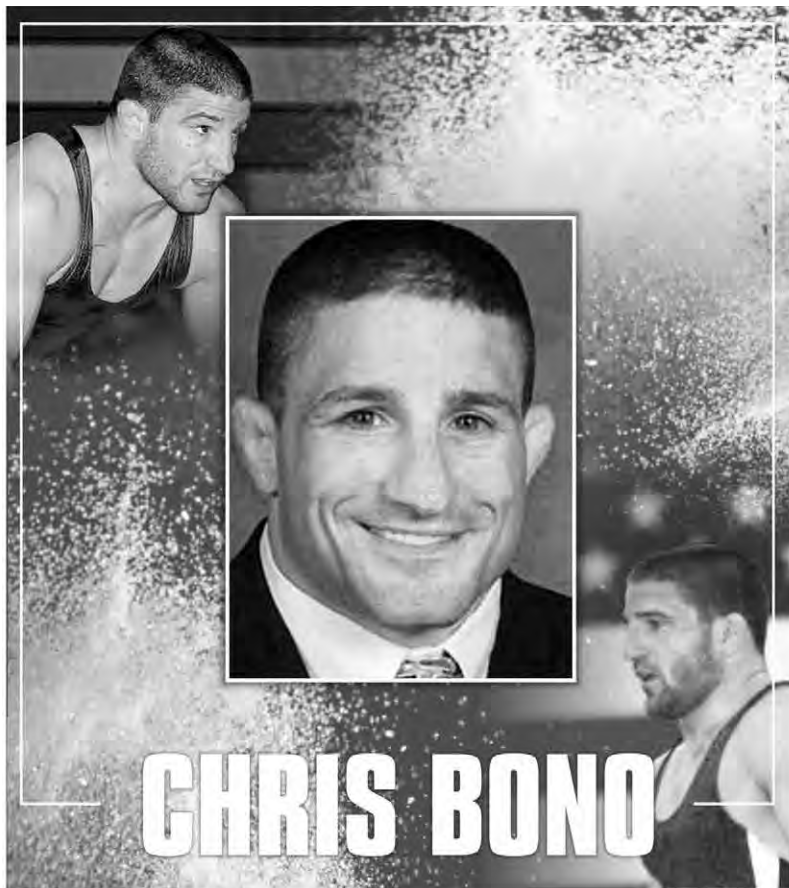

DR. KURT J. NELLIS MEMORIAL AWARD

The Dr. Kurt J. Nellis Memorial Award was created to recognize individuals who have served their community in the sport of amateur wrestling.

Bruce Closson fits that criteria for his 10 years of coaching with Plum's Junior Olympic program.

But Closson is even more deserving of recognition for his 25 years of publicizing the sport through web site development that has taken wrestling coverage to a new level.

The web sites he created have been enjoyed by hundreds of thousands of wrestling fans across the country.

"When my son Billy wrestled at Plum and Lehigh University, it was almost impossible to find results of high school and college wrestling," Closson said. "The newspapers were doing some coverage, but were only covering the top wrestlers.

"I searched the internet and the only sites that covered wrestling were InterMat and The Mat, but both had limited coverage. I wanted to see everybody publicized, not just the top wrestlers. That's why I started WrestlingReport.com."

In 1995, Closson, a contractor by trade who had limited experience in the computer field, self-taught himself to design a wrestling web site that became the most visited wrestling site in the country.

"During the 1999-2000 season, the web site was getting two million hits a week," Closson said. "We covered high school and college wrestling. One of the features on our page was dual meet and tournament results."

The web site also featured rankings, photos, videos, and a forum that gave wrestling fans the opportunity to voice their opinions.

"I couldn't have done it without the help we received from fans and colleges that sent

summaries and press releases," Closson said. "Alan Brown coordinated our college coverage. Ron Garrison and Ken Wunderley helped me with the high school coverage."

WrestlingReport.com was one of the top five wrestling web sites in the country. The web site was named National Web Site of the Year by the National Wrestling Media Association in 2005.

Closson also developed web sites for the Eastern Wrestling League, Eastern Intercollegiate Wrestling Association, Powerade Wrestling Tournament, and Dapper Dan Wrestling Classic. He currently runs the site WPIALwrestling.net.

"I just love the sport of wrestling," said Closson, who has dealt with several health concerns since retiring as an independent contractor. "I live to promote wrestling. That's why I still do the web site. It's a lot of work, but very rewarding."

Ron Frank, President of the WPIAL Coaches Association, is glad to see that Closson is being honored.

"Bruce Closson played a part in building Plum's youth program, but he's best known for promoting wrestling through his web sites," said Frank, who recently stepped down as Fox Chapel's head coach. "He has also played an essential part on the Wrestling Classic selection committee in helping us evaluate and pick wrestlers."

Closson is a 1968 graduate of Penn Hills High School and was a three-sport athlete. Was a member of the track & field team three years, and two years with the football and wrestling teams. He attended Salem College in West Virginia, but the school did not have a wrestling program. He began coaching with the Plum Junior Wrestling team in 1979 and ran the program for 10 years.

"Bruce did a lot for Plum wrestling," said former Plum wrestler Steve Cassidy. "I spent a lot of time with Bruce and his son Billy. Bruce was at every event and took us to every tournament.

"But Bruce is best known for his web sites. He was the first to have a wrestling forum. It was the first form of what we now know as twitter. His web sites reported all the summaries, but also allowed fans to voice their opinion."

Closson recently completed his 25th season of wrestling coverage. It's quite appropriate that he is being honored at the Pittsburgh Wrestling Classic, since today (March 14) marks his 70th birthday.

Bruce has been married to his wife Donna for 49 years. They have two kids - Bill and Jennifer - and five grandchildren.

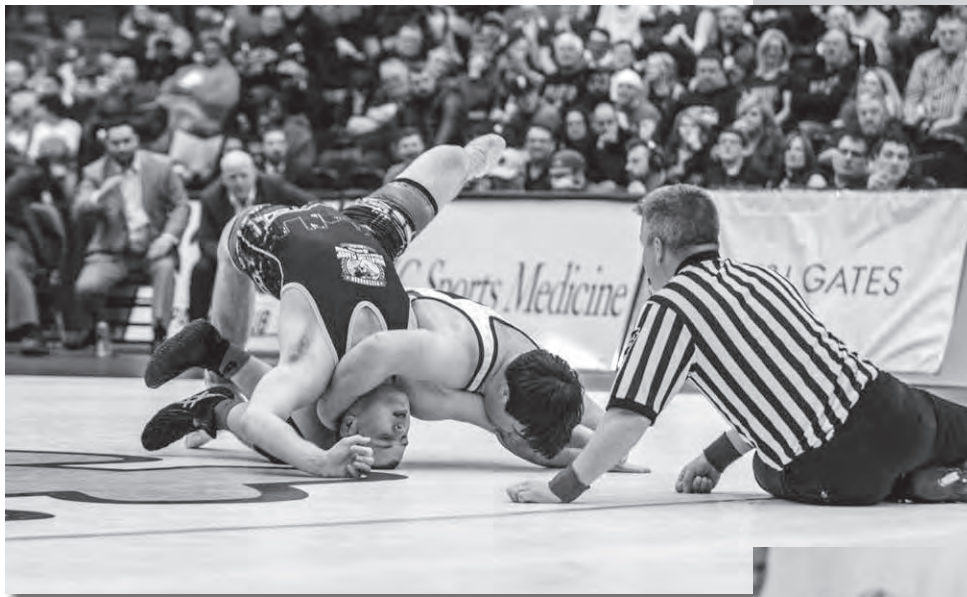

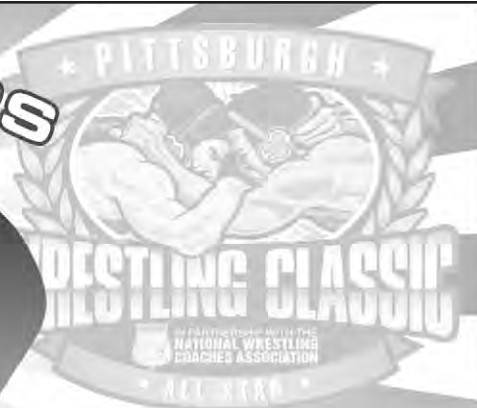

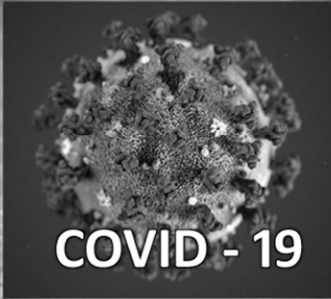

DAVE CIAFRE

Ciafre is a 1966 graduate of Shaler High School and a 1975 graduate of the University of Pittsburgh with a degree in Counselor Education. Ciafre began his 40-year wrestling coaching career in 1979 as a junior high coach at Riverview High School, then moved up to the junior varsity two years later. In 1986, he became the head coach and served four seasons at Riverview. After a two-year coaching stint at Mercersburg Academy, Ciafre became the head coach at Sharon High School

in 1993. He recently completed his 27th season at Sharon. He has coached 41 section champions, 82 district placemen, 40 regional placemen, 18 PIAA state placemen and three PIAA state champions. He served as a coach with Pennsylvania USA Wrestling from 1985-97, and worked as a coach at Clarion University Wrestling Camps from 1982-2016. He also served as a freestyle and Greco-Roman official from 1983-97 and was named Pennsylvania USA Wrestling Official of the Year in 1989.



JIMMY GULIBON

Gulibon is a 2012 graduate of Derry High School and a 2017 graduate of Penn State University. Gulibon is one of 30 wrestlers to win four WPIAL titles. He is also one of 13 individuals who have won four PIAA titles. He also won four titles at the Powerade Christmas Tournament and finished his career with a 136-4 record. He posted a 39-1 record as a 103-pound freshman and won WPIAL and PIAA Class 3A titles. He moved up to 112

as a sophomore and claimed two more titles en route to a 36-1 record. Derry moved to Class 2A for his junior year and Gulibon won WPIAL, Southwest Region, and PIAA titles at 119 and finished with a 36-1 record. Gulibon moved up to 126 pounds as a senior and won all three tournaments, finishing with a 25-1 record. At Penn State, Gulibon posted a 75-47 record as a four-year starter. He qualified for the NCAA Division I Tournament all four years and placed fifth in the country as a 133-pound sophomore.



JOHN HNATH

Hnath is a 1982 graduate of Mt. Lebanon High School and a 1987 graduate of the University of Pittsburgh. He qualified for the WPIAL Class 3A Tournament as a 119-pound sophomore. He returned at the same weight as a junior and placed second in the WPIAL. At Pitt, he was a four-year starter and two-time team captain. He qualified for the NCAA Division I Tournament in 1985. He also served one year as a graduate assistant at Pitt. He returned to Mt. Lebanon as an assistant coach and

was instrumental in starting up the Mt. Lebanon Youth Wrestling Association. He served as head youth coach from 2002-06. He began refereeing while coaching at Mt. Lebanon, then switched to it full time. He was chosen to referee for the PIAA State Championships twice and served as the Pittsburgh Chapter of Officials President from 2001- 2013. He continues to do high profile NCAA matches and all-star competitions and has been chosen to referee the NCAA Division I Championships 10 times.



JORDAN SHIELDS

Shields is a 2008 graduate of Burrell High School and a 2013 graduate of Mercyhurst University. Shields is one of 30 wrestlers to win four WPIAL titles. He was also a three-time Class 2A Southwest Region champion, and a two-time PIAA finalist. Shields won his first WPIAL title as a 103-pound freshman and finished with a 33-15 record. He moved to 112 as a sophomore and won WPIAL and Southwest Region titles, made his first PIAA appearance, and finished with a 42-6 record. As a 130-pound junior, he won WPIAL, region,

and PIAA titles en route to a 42-4 record. He moved to 140 as a senior and won WPIAL and region titles, and placed second in the PIAA, finishing with a 46-2 record. He compiled a 162-25 career record. Burrell won a PIAA Class 2A team title during his senior year. At Mercyhurst, Shields was an NCAA Division II All-American and Academic All-American in 2011. He also served as a youth wrestling coach with the Mat Factory from 2013-19.

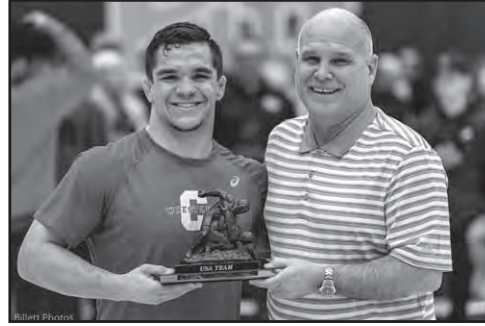

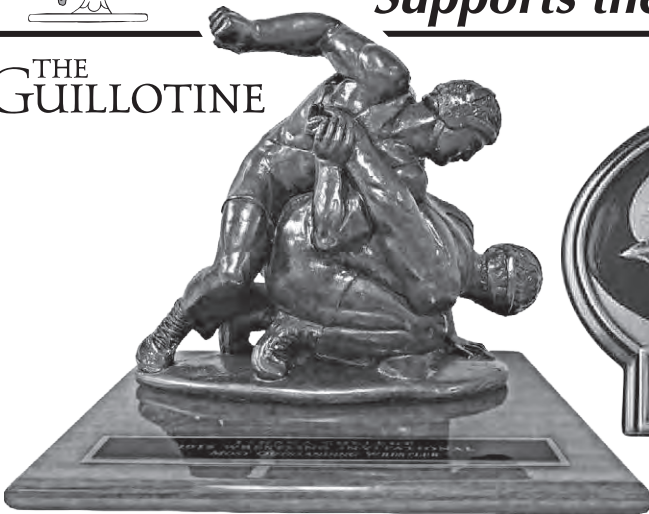

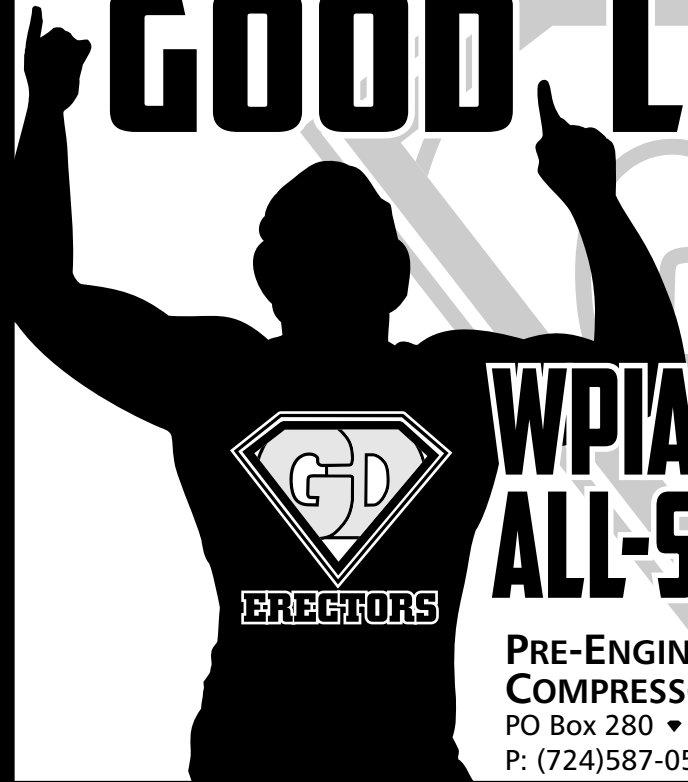

High school athletics have been shut down in the state of California for the entire 2020-21 school year. And classes are being held via Zoom since all the schools are closed.

But that hasn't stopped Adrienna Turner from competing in the sport she loves - wrestling.

"It stinks that we can't go to school and compete in high school sports," said Turner, a senior at Davis High School who has been a top-four finisher in the California Interscholastic Federation Tournament the past two years. "There's still a chance we will have a state wrestling tournament, but the chances are very slim."

Despite the scholastic sports shutdown, Turner has been attending out-of-state tournaments.

"I've been training with the Central Catholic Wrestling Club and my coach Emilio Saavedra," Adrienna Turner said. "We've been to tournaments in Florida and Iowa, both individual and team tournaments. It's certainly helped to fill the void of no high school sports."

One of those Tournaments was the Brian Keck Memorial Preseason Nationals, which was held Oct. 30 and Nov. 1 at the Iowa Events Center in Des Moines, Iowa. Turner won the 127-pound weight class in the Girls High School Division with a 2-0 overtime decision over Montana DeLawder, who competes with the Haines Trained Wrestling Club in Gettysburg, Pa.

The title earned Turner the No. 1 ranking in Flowrestling.com's national rankings, while DeLawder moved into the No. 2 spot.

The next destination for Turner and her mother Heather is Pennsylvania as she has been picked to compete in the 47th Annual Pittsburgh Wrestling Classic. She will face DeLawder, a Gettysburg High School senior, in a 127-pound to be held prior to the boys feature match between all-star teams from the United States and Pennsylvania.

"I'm not familiar with The Wrestling Classic, but I'm very excited about the opportunity to compete," Turner said. "I'm really looking forward to another match with Montana."

DeLawder, a four-time Pennsylvania Girls state champion, is very familiar with The Wrestling Classic.

"I've never attended, but I watch it every year," DeLawder said. "I have a couple friends who have been in The Classic before. In fact, Vayle Baker (a 2019 participant in The Classic) reached out to me and told me how much fun she had at The Classic. I also know (Gettysburg graduate) Ken Haines, who wrestled for the Pennsylvania All-Star Team (in 1995). It's a great event. I'm really looking forward to it."

DeLawder is looking forward to the rematch with Hunter.

"I've replayed that match in my head a hundred times," DeLawder said. "I know where I can improve. I'm looking forward to the rematch."

DeLawder recently won her fourth Pennsylvania Girls Wrestling state championship after finishing her high school career against boys with 85 wins, which is a state record.

"Montana is a trailblazer for girls wrestling in Pennsylvania," said Dan Heckert, head coach of North Allegheny's girls team. "She is the first girl from a public high school to compete in The Wrestling Classic, the Rose Bowl of Wrestling. It will be great to see Montana showcase her talents. I will be watching on Flowrestling.com."

DeLawder recently accepted a scholarship from King University, located in Bristol, Tennessee. Turner has accepted a scholarship to wrestle at Grand View University, located in Des Moines, Iowa. Both schools have very successful girls wrestling programs.

Hempfield High School hit the trifecta when the WPIAL All-Star Team was announced for the preliminary match of the Pittsburgh Wrestling Classic. Three of the 12 entries are from Hempfield.

“It’s a tremendous honor for our program to have three wrestlers chosen in the same year,” Hempfield coach Vince DeAugustine said. “We’ve had kids chosen before, but not three in one year. All three were bronze medalists at Hershey and all three placed more than once. It’s a fitting way to see their careers end with a match at The Classic.”

Hempfield has had 15 wrestlers compete in previous Classics. Three Spartans have appeared in the feature match for the Pennsylvania All-Star Team, including DeAugustine, while 12 others appeared on the WPIAL All-Star Team.

“Wrestling in The Classic is something I’m very proud of,” said DeAugustine, who competed at 160 pounds in 1997. “I wasn’t happy with the result. I lost in overtime, but it was a great experience. The Classic committee treated us like gold. Everything is first class. I told the kids to go out and have fun.”

Hempfield’s three entries are: Ethan Berginc, Ty Linsenbigler, and Isaiah Vance.

Berginc (124-40), a West Point recruit, is a two-time PIAA Class 3A placewinner who won a title in 2020. His opponent at 120 pounds is Cooper Flynn (132-17), a Virginia Tech recruit from McDonogh School, who is a three-time National Prep All-American and one-time champ. Flynn is ranked No. 2 nationally by Flowrestling.com.

Linsenbigler (148-27), a Lock Haven recruit and three-time PIAA placewinner, has moved up one weight class to 152. He is facing Michael Emerick (137-15), a Maryland state champion from Damascus High School. Emerick will be attending the U.S. Merchant Marine Academy.

Vance (147-19), a West Point Recruit, is a three-time PIAA placewinner at 285 pounds. He is facing the most accomplished member of the Maryland All-Star Team, Kyonte Hamilton (150-11), a two-time Maryland state champ and one-time national prep champ from Georgetown Prep.

Hamilton will also be the busiest wrestler at The Classic, as he will perform in both matches. Hamilton was originally chosen on the United States All-Star Team, but then agreed to wrestle in both matches when other heavy-weights from Maryland were not available.

“Ethan, Ty, and Isaiah have a lot to be proud of, especially when you consider what they went through this year with all the Covid restrictions. Their accomplishments are even more magnified, as their road was tougher than any year in their career. I’m very proud of them.”

Hampton’s Justin Hart (136-28) is following in the footsteps of his brother Jake Hart, who wrestled in the 2012 Classic for the Pennsylvania All-Stars. He is also competing in the same weight class.

“I’ve been going to The Classic for years,” Justin Hart said. “My brother Jake was picked to be on the Pennsylvania team his senior year. He’s always wanted the same for me.”

Hart, a PIAA Class 3A runner-up and Virginia Military recruit, will face Grant Warner (100-22), a two-time Maryland state finalist and one-time champ from Manchester Valley High School, at 195 pounds.

“Jake told me how much fun he had at The Classic,” Justin Hart said. “He said it was a great experience. I’m looking forward to it.”

Pine-Richland’s Cole Spencer (130-18), a three-time PIAA Class 3A placewinner and Pennsylvania University recruit, is the WPIAL’s 160-pound entry. He will face Harrison Trahan (132-35), a two-time Maryland state champ and National Prep runner-up from McDonogh.

Freedom’s Trent Schultheis (150-35), a four-time PIAA Class 2A placewinner and Pitt recruit, is entered at 182 pounds. Schultheis will face Gene Quodala (109-26), a two-time Maryland state champ from Bullis School.

Columbia recruit Kenny Duschek (142-37) will be Blackhawk’s first Classic participant. Duschek, a two-time PIAA Class 2A placewinner, will face another wrestler from McDonogh, Matt Lawrence (97-30), a Maryland state champ.

Kiski Area’s Sammy Starr (113-46), a two-time WPIAL Class 3A runner-up, is the 170-pound entry. He will face James Conway (130-37), a Maryland state champ and Franklin & Marshall recruit from Loyola High School.

Norwin’s John Altieri (124-33), a PIAA Class 3A runner-up and two-time placewinner, is the 145-pound entry. Altieri, a Clarion recruit, will face Damon McGee (97-9), a National Prep placewinner from Bullis School.

The WPIAL All-Star Team’s other three entries are: Franklin Regional’s Carter Dibert (150-16) at 126, Burrell’s Ian Oswald (163-24) at 132, and Armstrong’s Logan Harmon (70-17) at 220.

Dibert is a three-time top-three PIAA Class 3A finisher, will face Jabari Pinkney (72-12), a Norwich recruit from Hammond High School, at 126.

Oswald, a four-time WPIAL Class 2A champ and two-time PIAA runner-up, will face Nico D’Amico (152-20), a Maryland state champ from Stephen Decatur High School, at 132 pounds.

“I’ve been going to The Classic since I was a kid,” Oswald said. “My neighbor used to get free tickets every year and always gave me one. Now I get a chance to wrestle in The Classic.”

Harmon is a WPIAL Class 3A runner-up and PIAA placewinner. His opponent was not confirmed when the program was printed.

Wyatt Henson has followed in his father's footsteps in the sport of wrestling. Henson, a Waynesburg High School senior, is the son of former U.S. Olympian Sammie Henson.

"We both won three state titles in high school and we both placed fifth in our freshman year," said Wyatt Henson, after winning his third state title at Hershey on March 13. "And we both got picked for the Pittsburgh Wrestling Classic. The only difference is that I will be on the Pennsylvania All-Star Team."

Sammie Henson was a member of the United States All-Star Team in 1989 after winning three Missouri state titles at Francis Howell High School. He wrestled in the 112-pound bout and defeated North Schuylkill's Randy Reidler, 8-7. Henson was inducted in the Wrestling Classic's Hall of Fame in 2018.

"I'm really looking forward to wrestling in The Classic," Wyatt Henson said. "It's a great way to finish my high school career. It's going to be awesome."

Wyatt Henson (159-20), an Iowa recruit, was scheduled to face Shayne Van Ness (104-3), a National Prep champion and Penn State recruit from Blair Academy, in the 145-pound bout. Van Ness withdrew after competing in the Olympic Trials Last Chance Qualifier. Henson's will face his future teammate at Iowa, Caleb Rathjen. Rathjen is a 4-time state finalist and 2-time Iowa state champion, with 133-6 career record. He is ranked No.16 in the country at 152 lbs. by Flowrestling.com.

Henson will be joined on the Pennsylvania All-Star Team by Waynesburg teammate Luca Augustine (122-24), a PIAA Class 3A champion and Pitt recruit. Augustine's opponent in the 170-pound bout is Dillon Walker (82-17) of LaSalle High School in Cincinnati.

Seneca Valley will also be represented by two wrestlers on the Pennsylvania All-Star

Team: Alejandro Herrera-Rondon and Dylan Chappell.

Herrera-Rondon (175-14), a three-time PIAA Class 3A champion and Oklahoma recruit, will wrestle in the 152-pound bout against Victor Voinovich (148-16), a two-time Ohio state champion and Oklahoma State recruit from Brecksville High School. Voinovich is ranked No. 1 and Herrera-Rondon is No. 3.

"It's a great honor to be chosen to wrestle in The Classic," Herrera-Rondon said. "Victor Voinovich is No. 1 in the country. That's something to be excited about. I want to show everybody what I can do against the No. 1 guy."

Chappell (164-26), a three-time PIAA runner-up and Bucknell recruit, is paired up with Chance Lamer (136-6), a Michigan recruit and three-time Oregon state champion, in the 132-pound bout.

"It's an honor to be chosen," Chappell said. "I'm looking forward to it. It's a great way to end my high school career and one more chance to have Alejandro as my teammate."

The other two WPIAL entries on the Pennsylvania All-Star Team are: South Park's Joey Fischer and Burrell's A.J. Corrado.

Fischer (142-13), a Clarion recruit, is a two-time PIAA Class 2A finalist and one-time champ. His opponent at 126 pounds is Drake Ayala (171-3), a three-time Iowa state champ and Iowa University recruit from Fort Dodge.

Corrado (155-35), a Brown recruit, is a two-time PIAA Class 2A finalist and one-time champ. His opponent at 160 pounds is Oklahoma State recruit Enrique Munguia (145-33), a two-time Ohio state runner-up from Elyria High School.

Ayala and Lamer are among five members of the United States All-Star Team who have

won three state titles. The others are: Richard Figueroa, Carter Young, and Jaxon Smith.

Figueroa (123-2), an Arizona State recruit, is a three-time California state champion from Selma High School. His opponent at 120 pounds is Brett Ungar (143-5), a two-time state champion and Cornell recruit from Notre Dame Green Pond.

"I took down the No. 8 and No. 5 ranked guys at the state tournament," Ungar said. "Now I get a chance to wrestle the No. 1 guy. I can't wait to see what I can do against him."

Young (156-7), Northwestern recruit, is a three-time Oklahoma champ from Stillwater. His opponent at 138 is Brock McMillen (142-8), a three-time PIAA Class 2A champ and Pitt recruit from Glendale High School.

Smith (115-1), a Maryland recruit, is a three-time Georgia recruit from Woodland-Cartersville High. He will face Nazareth's Drew Clearie (109-34), a Brown recruit and two-time PIAA Class 3A bronze medalist.

The other three members of the United States All-Star Team are: Keyonte Hamilton, Emmanuel Skillings, and Peyton Craft.

Hamilton (150-11), a Rutgers recruit, is a two-time National Prep champ from Georgetown Prep. His opponent at 285 pounds is Selinsgrove's Nate Schon (144-7), a two-time PIAA Class 3A champ and Iowa State recruit from Selinsgrove.

Skillings (116-14), a two-time Oklahoma state champ from Broken Arrow High School, will face Cumberland Valley's Jacob Lucas (140-21), a PIAA Class 3A champ and Naval Academy recruit, at 220.


Craft (118-16) is a two-time National Prep runner-up and Cornell recruit. His opponent at 182 is Montoursville's Cael Crebs (137-18), a PIAA Class 3A champ and Naval Academy recruit.

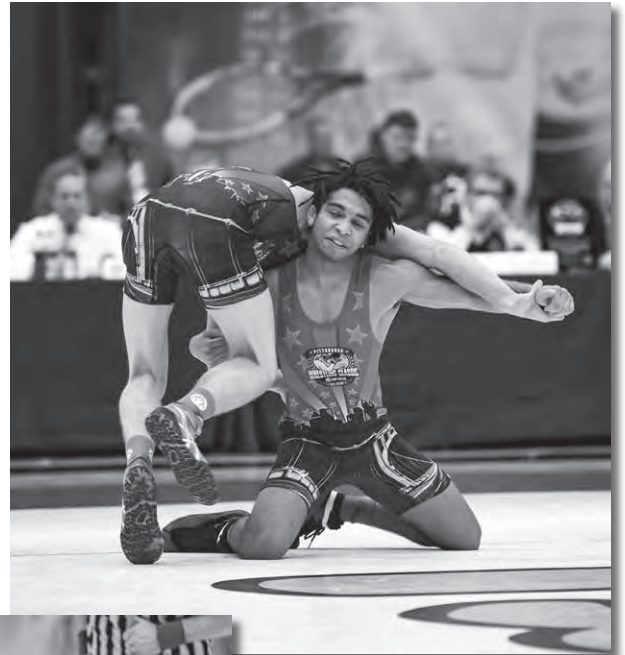

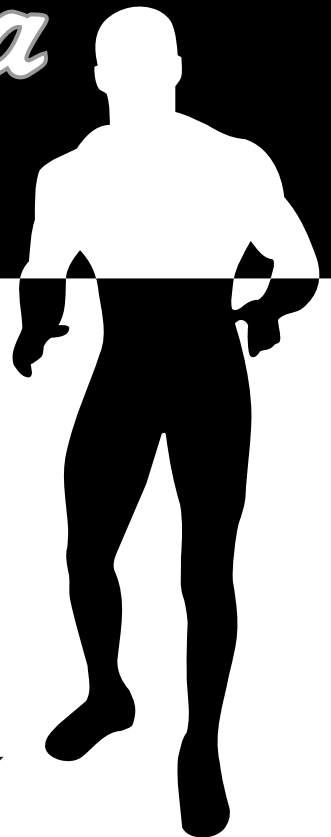
